- **All students need indoor shoes suitable for Phys. Ed.**
- A gym t-shirt and shorts need to be purchased from the school for students in grades 1 – 12 (students order in late September). Uniforms must be labelled with student's name.
- A draw string or similar bag with student's name is useful to contain the gym uniform in the locker.
- Please send in 2 boxes of tissues with each student at the start of the school year.
- **Please remember it is necessary to replenish supplies throughout the year.**

High school students

2213 - 2 supports 34" high and 2 shelves 13" wide -Price with discount \$26.99

Elementary students

2412 - 2 supports 24" high with 2 shelves 12" wide, 11" deep -Price with discount \$26.99

DAYTIMERS ARE PROVIDED FOR EVERY STUDENT GRADE 1 – 9

- JK/SK** A large Ziploc bag **labeled** with extra clothes appropriate for the season. Indoor and outdoor **Velcro** shoes (**no laces or flip flops please**). 2 boxes of Kleenex each. A refillable water bottle that can be brought back and forth to school each day. A durable fabric bag with a small blanket and pillow for quiet time.
- GRADE 1** Markers, sharpened coloured pencils, a set of three (red, black, blue) wipe-off markers (with the wipe-off felt at one end), 5 large glue sticks, and Velcro shoes only, for indoor and outdoor wear. Note: Indoor shoes should be suitable for gym classes. (soft-soled, with Velcro fasteners, sturdy and comfortable). A small pencil box or pencil case.
- GRADE 2** 1 pencil case, 1 red, green and blue pen, 1 box pencil crayons (sharpened), scissors, a pencil sharpener (that has a closed part to catch the shavings), 4 large glue sticks, markers (thin and thick tips), 3 boxes of sharpened pencils with erasers (Studio, Classmate, or Papermate – please no decorated pencils), erasers, a long ruler (cm & inches), 2 packs of white board markers, and 1 sturdy pocket folder/ agenda bag. Please also send in 7 duotangs, 1 of each of the following colours: **red, light blue, medium blue, green, grey, yellow, orange**. Please **do not** label supplies or duotangs, this will be done in class. Please check and replenish as the year progresses. Thanks!
- GRADE 3** Pencil case/box, scissors, sharpened coloured pencils, washable markers, pencil sharpener (with spot for collecting shavings), 1 pack of whiteboard markers, long metric ruler, 2 erasers, 1 large glue stick, 1 red pen, 24 sharpened pencils, 6 **unlabeled** duotangs (red, green, blue, black, orange, purple, yellow) 2 labeled durable pocket folders, one 1" 3-ring binder, 1 pack of blank white paper, 1 pack lined paper, 1 set of labeled headphones for computer use, labeled USB memory stick.
- GRADE 4** Students must supply their own material except for textbooks and accompanying workbooks. Recommended tools include: small carabiner for locker door, scissors, pencil-case, 24 pencils, red & blue pens, pencil crayons, markers, sketch book, 1 highlighter, ruler, eraser, 1 large glue stick, 1 package of lined paper (do not put it in duo tangs) **10 duo tangs (red, orange, green, blue, purple, yellow, black, white, dark blue, your choice for the 10th)** and 2 pocket folders. For French, one 1" blue 3-ring binder with inside pockets. Please do not label duo tangs. This will be done in class.
- GRADE 5** Students must supply all of their own materials except textbooks. Recommended tools include scissors, loose-leaf lined paper, five exercise books (21.5 cm by 27.5 cm), black & blue pens, pencils, metric ruler, erasers, glue sticks, pencil crayons, pencil case, math set with protractor & compass, 10 duo-tangs,

a set of markers, 2 Pocket Folders – one for Creative Writing and another for organizing, one (1”) binder – no bigger please. For French, one 1” blue 3-ring binder with inside pockets. **Each Gr. 5 student must have their own USB Memory Stick). An NIV Study Bible is highly recommended for Bible.**

GRADE 6 Students must supply all of their own materials except textbooks. Tools needed include *scissors*, 2 medium (not large) binders with subject *dividers*, plenty of loose leaf *lined paper*, *pens* (black or dark blue & 1 red), good supply of *pencils* (to get through the year), *eraser*, *metric ruler*, *whiteout tape*, large *glue stick*, *pencil crayons*, *pencil case*, *highlighter*, math *protractor*, *compass* (needed later on in the year), *re-enforcements*, one 80 page *notebook*, and an encased personal *pencil sharpener* (that will catch the shavings). For French, one 1” blue 3-ring binder with inside pockets. A USB memory stick is recommended. Optional: some students like a plastic box to place under the desk to hold the extra things overflowing the desk (like textbooks).

GRADE 7 Students must supply all of their own materials except textbooks. Tools needed are lined paper, blank paper and graph paper (for the year), a scientific calculator, math set (with ruler, protractor, compass), red and black pens, pencils, highlighters, scissors, coloured pencils, 2 binders, subject dividers, 2 large glue sticks, and scissors. For French, one 1” blue 3-ring binder with inside pockets. A Pocket dictionary is needed. 2 Packages of Hilroy Exercise Books (32 pages) (avail. at dollar store). A **USB memory stick** is also required.

GRADE 8 Students must supply all of their own materials except textbooks. Tools needed are 2 Packages of Hilroy Exercise books (32 pages) (available at Dollar Store or Staples), loose leaf paper, blank paper, graph paper, blue or black and red pens, pencils, scientific calculator, ruler, eraser, scissors, 2 large glue sticks, compass, protractor, pencil crayons, pencil case, a highlighter, 3 small or medium binders with dividers, a Sr. Dictionary. For French, one 1” blue 3-ring binder with inside pockets. A French English dictionary is strongly encouraged. **All grade 8 students must have their own USB Memory Stick. Note: It is NOT recommended that students buy the “large” ring binders as these are difficult to fit in the desk.**

SECONDARY SCHOOL

Students must supply all of their own materials except textbooks. Recommended tools include binders with subject dividers, loose-leaf paper, including square grid graph paper for math and sciences, black and red pens, pencils, ruler, eraser, 2 large glue sticks, compass, protractor, pencil crayons, pencils case. Students in grades 10, 11 & 12 will require a graphing calculator. The preferred make is Texas T1-83 Plus (available at Staples – cost approx. \$130.00 - \$150.00). Grade 9 students may wish to purchase one of these but a regular scientific calculator will suffice.

It is imperative that all calculators are marked with your student’s name on both the calculator & the case. Students also need to ensure they have extra batteries on hand at all times. Students should also have their names on any other devices brought to school for educational purposes such as laptops, USB devices, etc.

Students are able to use personal laptops for educational purposes while at school when they have teacher permission. However, there are a few important things to note. As a school, we use a Windows based environment (preferably Windows 10) and every student has access to the Office 365 software. **Although Apple Mac computers also use this software, connections can be more complicated.** This can cause problems when there is a need to print or a work period is approved for a project. If you are considering purchasing a digital device to assist your student, please keep this in mind. A USB storage device or external hard drive may be helpful as a backup, but is no longer necessary. The risk of virus contamination is also greater with a USB device.

ESL STUDENTS: It is highly recommended that ESL students purchase a translator device that DOES NOT have data or wifi connections. Although cell phones can be used, they are not allowed during exams.

Each student now has access to the full Office365 suite of applications. Office can be installed on up to 5 devices per student for school use. The office applications can be installed by going to the web site portal.mymca.ca and logging in with their MCA email address. As part of the Office 365 software, we will be using the OneDrive software to store school work so that it can be accessed at home and at school.
