Christian Homestays

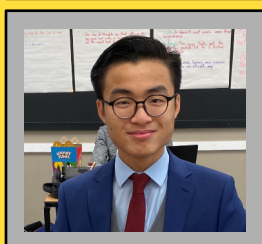

All students at Maranatha are required to live in a Christian home.

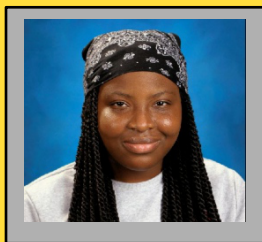


In their own words ...



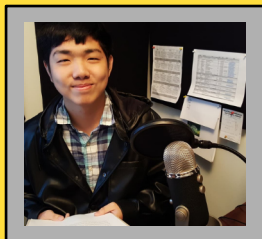
